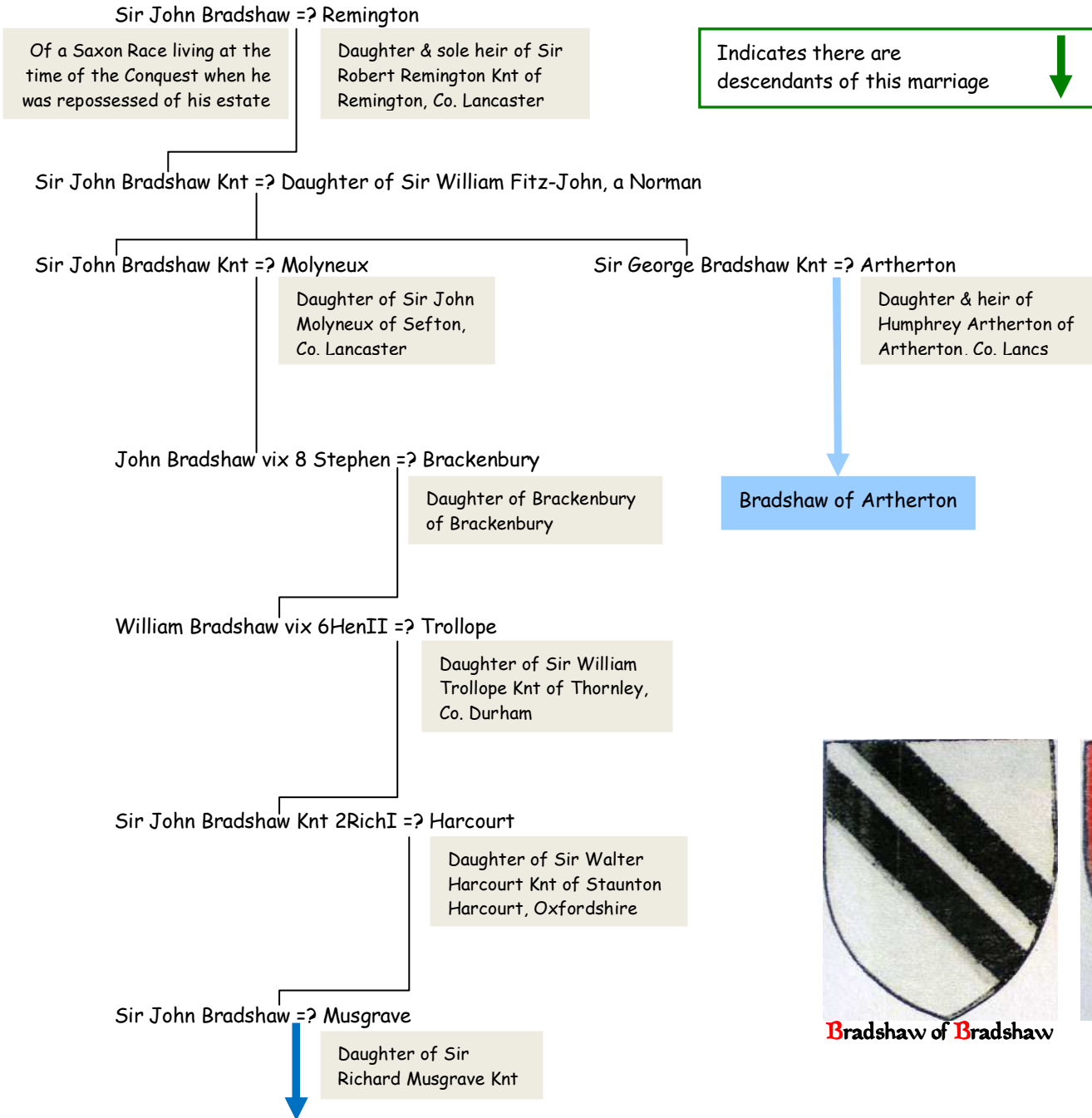
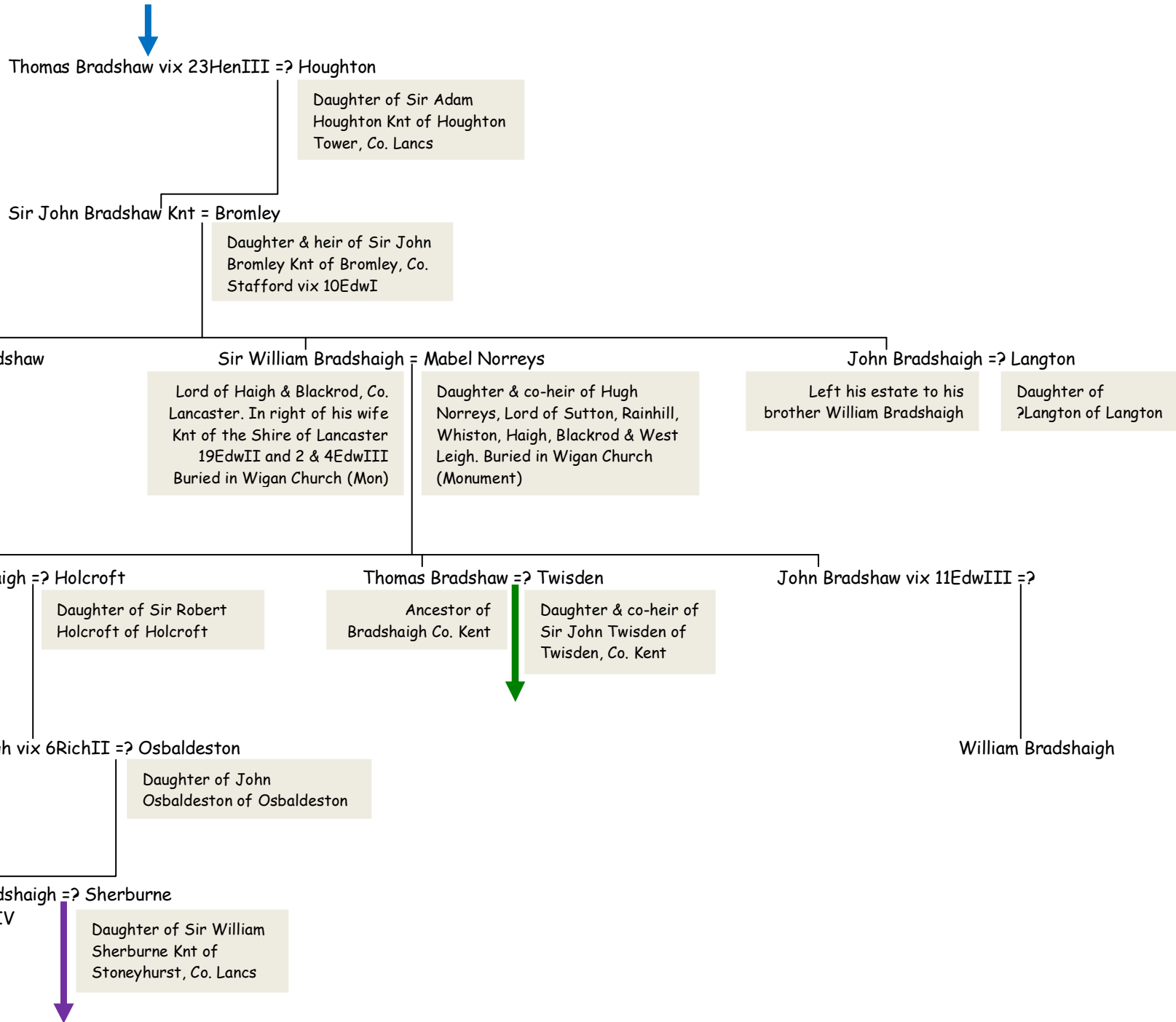
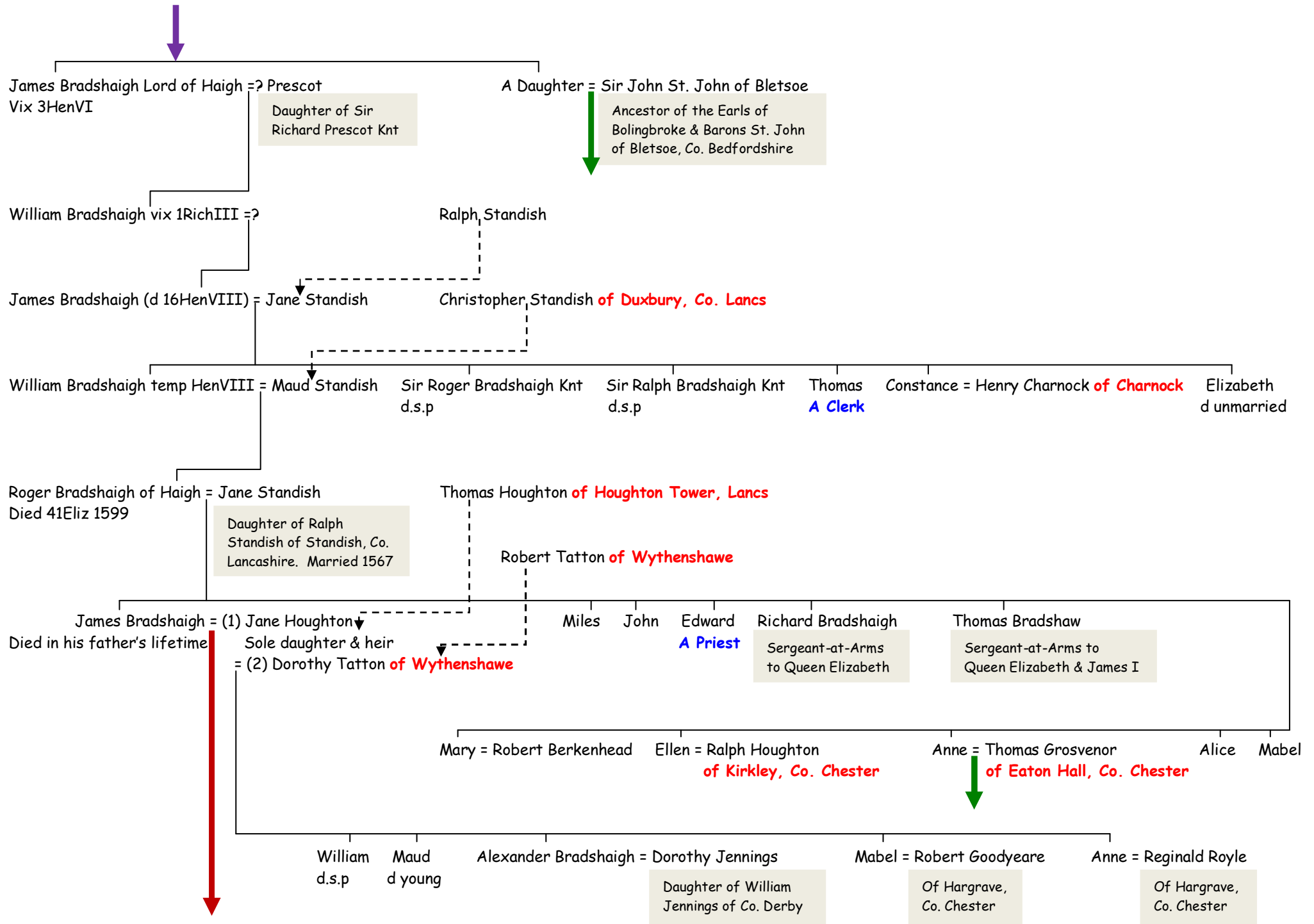
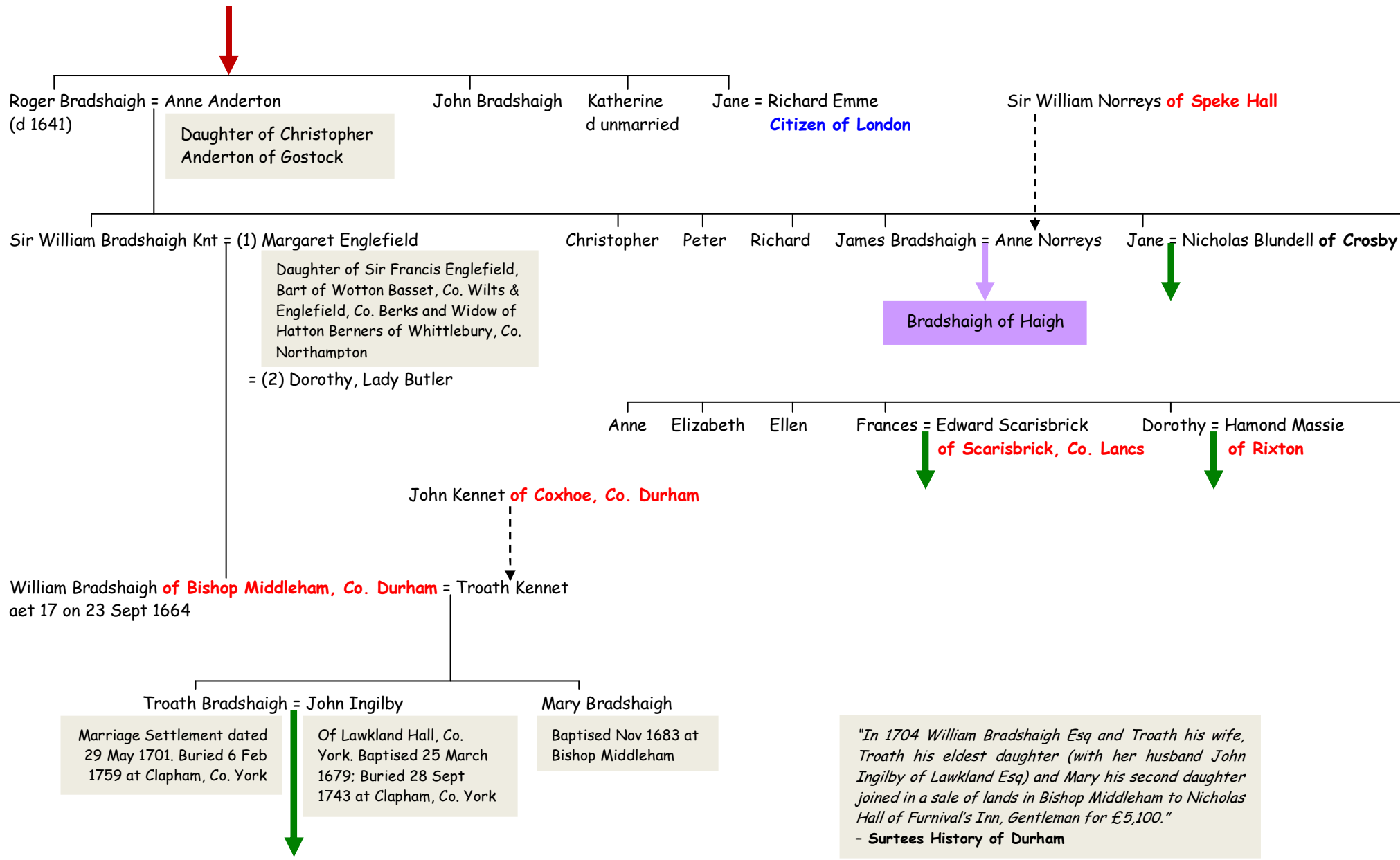


PEDIGREE OF BRADSHAIGH of the HAIGH

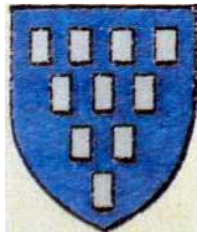
